We commit to use the gifts and talents God has blessed us with in service to Him and the common good to support our members, ministries, and mission of Poplar Springs Baptist Church.

We commit to be zealous in our efforts to advance the kingdom of our Savior, Jesus Christ; seeking the salvation of our family and friends, neighbors and the nations, by boldly proclaiming the good news of salvation in the name of Jesus Christ alone.

We commit to maintain the unity of the Spirit and bond of peace as we submit to one another and our leaders, watch over one another in brotherly love; admonish and entreat one another as occasion may require; remember each other in prayer; aid each other in sickness and distress; cultivate Christian sympathy in feeling and courtesy in speech; be slow to take offense, but always ready for reconciliation, and mindful of the commands and guidance of our Savior, to secure it without delay.

We commit that, if in the providence of God we remove from Poplar Springs Baptist Church, we will as soon as possible unite with some other like-minded church where we can carry out the spirit of this covenant and the principles of God's Word.
